* Voluntary Consumables Charge - For those children in receipt of Free Entitlement Funding

This charge helps us to cover the costs of your children's breakfast, snacks, nappies, wipes and suncream whilst they are at Teddy Wilf's, which West Sussex County Council have made clear are not covered by the Free Entitlement Funding. The Voluntary Consumables Charge will be automatically added to your invoice and will equate to £1.00 per core session (AM and PM). In return we will provide all nappies, wipes, breakfast, snacks and suncream for children at Teddy Wilf's Nurseries.

If you would prefer not to pay the additional £1.00 per session then families will be welcome to provide the nappies, wipes, snacks, breakfast and suncream for their child – please just let our Head Office Team know so your invoice can be amended accordingly.

Our Tea Sessions can be added to the Whole Day to create an extended Holiday Club day from 8:00am - 5:30pm.

The full balance must be paid at the time of booking and is non-refundable. If you have two or more children who all attend Teddy Wilf's @ The Westgate's Holiday Club they are eligible for a special discount! For each full price place booked, you will receive a 25% discount for one sibling. *Please Note: the sibling discount cannot be used in conjunction with FE Funding.*

Important Information

Our Baby Room is open Monday - Friday, from 8:00am - 5:30pm, 48 weeks per year. We only close for Bank Holidays and 2 weeks at Christmas. Full Nursery fees are payable at all times to maintain a child's place. However, families will be permitted two weeks (of their normal attendance) as holidays each academic year, during which they will receive a 50% discount on their fees.

Our Pre-School room is open Monday - Friday, from 8:00am - 5:30pm, 38 weeks per year during Term Time and we operate a Holiday Club 10 weeks of the year during the School Holidays. We close for all Bank Holidays and up to 2 weeks at Christmas. Full fees are payable during term time to maintain a child's place.

The entire Nursery will close for 5 Continuing Professional Development Days per the year. You will not be charged for these days and we will not claim any Free Entitlement Funding on these days.

Families can also stretch their Free Entitlement Funding to include the school holidays by utilising our Holiday Club sessions:

If families are in receipt of 15 hour funding, they have the option to stretch their free entitlement funding to include the school holidays. This will mean that instead of claiming 15 hours per week over 38 weeks, families will be able to access 12 hours per week over 48 weeks.

If families are in receipt of 30 hour funding, they have the option to stretch their free entitlement funding to include the school holidays. This will mean that instead of claiming 30 hours per week over 38 weeks, families will be able to access 24 hours per week over 48 weeks.

Financial Support for Parents

2 Year Funding – for eligible 2 year olds - If your family is in receipt of certain benefits, your child is adopted, under a Special Guardianship Order, receives Disability Living Allowance or has an EHCP then your child may be able to access 15 hours per week of free childcare during term time. Children are eligible from the term following their 2nd birthday (1st September, 1st January or 1st April). You must apply to West Sussex County Council for this funding and they will confirm your eligibility.

15 hour Universal Free Entitlement Funding – for ALL 3 & 4 year olds - All children aged 3 or 4 years old are entitled to 15 hours per week of free childcare during term time. Children are eligible from the term following their 3rd birthday (1st September, 1st January or 1st April). You do not need to apply for this funding – we claim it on your behalf, we just need you to complete a 'Parent Declaration' which we will give you once your child eligible.

15 hour Extended Free Entitlement Funding – for eligible 3 & 4 year olds - If any Parents living in the household are working at least 16 hours per week at minimum wage, all year, then you are eligible for an additional 15 hours per week during term time, bringing the total to 30 hours per week. Children are eligible from the term following their 3rd birthday (1st September, 1st January or 1st April). You will have to apply online for this funding via www.childcarechoices.gov.uk and they will confirm your eligibility. You will then need to log in and reconfirm your eligibility every 3 months otherwise you will lose the funding.

Tax Free Childcare – for eligible children aged 0 – 11 years old - If you are working at least 16 hours per week at minimum wage, all year, and you are paying for childcare – the Government could help you by paying up to £2000 per year. For every £8.00 you pay into your Tax Free Childcare account, the Government will top it up by £2.00. *Please note, this cannot be used in conjunction with Universal Credit.*

Universal Credit – for eligible children aged 0 – 16 years old - If you are in receipt of Universal Credit, you could be entitled to support with your childcare costs. This is dependent on your individual circumstances but could be worth £951.00 per month for one child or £1,630 per month for two or more children.

Support Whilst you Study - There is various financial support for Parents who are studying (Care to Learn, Discretionary Learners Support and Childcare Grants) as well as financial support from individual learning providers (e.g. Chichester College will, in certain circumstances, help pay for childcare whilst you study).
